GH/SH/34/ 2022/PVS/102020/13/S:- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 20 read with section 4 of the Gujarat Professional Technical Educational Colleges or Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fees) Act, 2007 (Guj. 2 of 2008), the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Master of Engineering and Technology and Master of Pharmacy Courses (Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) Rules, 2020, namely:-

- 1. These rules may be called the Master of Engineering and Technology and Master of Pharmacy Courses (Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) Rules, 2022.
- 2. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 3. In the Master of Engineering and Technology and Master of Pharmacy Course (Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) Rules, 2020, in rule 20 (1), for sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-
 - "(1) In Government and aided Colleges / Institution after offering admission to all the candidates whose names appear in the merit list or after completion of the online admission process, the vacant seats arising due to non-allotment shall be filled by Admission Committee through online/offline counseling in the following order, namely:-
 - (i) the names of the candidates whose name appear in the merit list of the Admission Committee:
 - (ii) after allotting the seats to candidates mentioned in clause of (i) above, if seats remain vacant, the Admission Committee shall fill such seats by inviting the application from the candidates who have cleared the qualifying examination with minimum eligibility criteria prescribed in rule 5 but have neither qualified in GATE/GPAT nor appeared in the Common Entrance Test of the corresponding year, conducted by the Admission Committee. The merit list shall be prepared on

the basis of percentage of marks obtained at qualifying examination".

- (2) For the sub-rule (2), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-
 - "(2) In the unaided college or institution, after offering admission to all the candidates whose names appear in the merit list or after completion of the online admission process, if the seats remain vacant, such vacant seats shall be filled by the unaided college or institution as Management Seat. Such vacant seats shall be filled by unaided college or institution by inviting application from the eligible candidates and preparing common inter-se merit-list.

The Admission Committee shall, by an advertisement in the prominent newspapers widely circulated in the State, by web-site and by such other means, as it may consider convenient, display the details of vacant seats and schedule for vacant seats admission. The candidates who are already having the merit number of Admission Committee shall have to submit copy of his registration form to participate for the vacant seats round at concerned institution of his choice. Whereas the eligible candidates who have not registered earlier shall have to apply at institute level as per schedule declared by Admission Committee.

All eligible/merit candidates shall have to approach to unaided institutes of his choice for admission in vacant seats. An acknowledgement shall be given to candidate by concern unaided institutions. The concern unaided institutions shall process the filling up of vacant seats among such eligible candidates who have applied for vacant seats admission process by preparing common intra-se merit list in the following order and guidelines issued by the Admission Committee from time to time:

- (i) the names of the candidates whose name appear in the merit list of the Admission Committee;
- (ii) after allotting the seats to candidates mentioned in Clause (i) above, if seats remain vacant, the unaided colleges or institutions shall fill such seats by inviting the application from the candidates who have cleared the qualifying examination with minimum eligibility criteria prescribed in rule 5 but have neither qualified in GATE/GPAT nor appeared in the Common Entrance Test of the corresponding

year, conducted by the Admission Committee. The merit list shall be prepared based on percentage of marks obtained at qualifying examination.

- (3) In the said rules, for the words and letters "Any other course/specialization as and when approved by AICTE and/or PCI from time to time", under Appendix I, the following portion shall be substituted, namely:-
- * Any other course/specialization as and when approved by AICTE and/or PCI from time to time. The eligibility and equivalency of such courses shall be in line with Notification issued by AICTE vide No. F. No. 27/RIFD/Pay/01/2017-18, dated 28.4.2017 and/or Resolution issued by Education department. Government of Gujarat for Equivalency of various Graduate and Post-graduate degree courses in Engineering or Technology vide No. SCT/102013/616356/GH dated 6.7.2019".
